There was a general discussion initiated by Bill Walker that all of Fishing Tournaments supported by the club would be for Bass only and that any member was free to put on Fishing Tournaments for other fish but without the financial and logistic support of the club. The Board approved this position. The secretary was requested to relay this information to the club membership.

The Board had a good deal of discussion on whether to limit the Anglers in our Fishing Tournaments to one rod in the water at one time. This was specifically addressed as an issue with those trolling but would include all Anglers in the tournaments. Larry Yoda and Tony Marcengill presented their feelings on this issue as trollers who favored two rods per angler.

The vote was 5-4 against confining the tournament to one rod per angler and 6-3 for allowing a maximum of two rods per angler.

Bill Walker will refine the new form for reporting fish caught during the tournaments to include instructions on how to fill out the form.

There was a discussion on changing the months for the Fishing Tournaments but the Board voted to keep it as it has been.

The board voted to change the Yearly Longest Bass Caught.

- Eliminate Bass Species.
- Caught anytime during the year including the tournaments.
- One prize per person
- Prizes to be \$20 for the largest and \$10 for the next 9 largest.

The Board voted to move the deadline for registration for the Fishing Tournaments two weeks in order to allow new novice members to fish with a mentor prior to the Tournament.
